

**BY-LAW NO. 1010**

**OF THE**

**TOWN OF ST. PAUL**

**A By-Law of the Town of St. Paul, in the Province of Alberta  
to authorize the provision of Provincial E-911 services to be  
provided to the residents of the Town of St. Paul.**

Whereas, pursuant to Section 54 of the Municipal Government Act, a municipality may provide any service or thing that is provided in all, or part of the municipality in another municipal authority with the agreement of the other municipal authority.

And Whereas, pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act R.S.A. 1994, Chapter M. 26.1 and amendments thereto, a Council may pass By-Laws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property.

And Whereas, the Council of the Town of St. Paul wishes to provide Provincial E-911 service within the Municipality and enter into agreements with other agencies and/or municipalities to provide such service.

Now Therefore, the Council of the Town of St. Paul duly assembled and acts as follows:

1. The Town of St. Paul will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. to provide access to emergency services via its Provincial E-911 service.
2. The Town of St. Paul will enter into an agreement with Strathcona County to provide the E-911 Call Answer Services.
3. The Town of St. Paul will enter into agreement with Telus Communication Inc. in order that Telus will act as a billing and collecting agent for the Call Answer Service.
4. A customer within the Town of St. Paul who subscribes to Telus Exchange Service will be provided with the E-911 service and be required to pay fees for said service.
5. This By-Law shall take effect on the day of its final passing thereof.
