

BY-LAW #1017
OF THE
TOWN OF ST. PAUL

**A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF ST. PAUL, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO
AUTHORIZE THE COLLECTION OF TAXES BY INSTALMENTS.**

Whereas, under the provisions of Section 340 of the Municipal Government Act R.S.A. 1994 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of St. Paul has the authority to pass such a By-Law.

Therefore, the Council of the Town of St. Paul duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1) That property taxes of the Town of St. Paul can be made by instalments at the option of the taxpayer.
- 2) Persons interested in tax instalment payments must enter into an agreement with the Town of St. Paul authorizing the method of payment.
- 3) The Agreement shall set out the amount and due dates of the instalments.
- 4) A Taxpayers privilege of continuing in the tax payment plan will be cancelled if two instalments fail to be honoured in any year.

This By-Law shall come into affect upon the final passing thereof.
