

BY-LAW NO. 1041
OF THE
TOWN OF ST. PAUL

**A By-Law of the Municipal Council of the Town of St. Paul,
in the Province of Alberta, being a By-Law to establish a
Assessment Review Board.**

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994 and amendments thereto and under the provisions of Section 454 and 455 thereof, the Council of the Town of St. Paul, in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

An Assessment Review Board of the Town of St. Paul is hereby established to hear and make a decision on assessment appeals received from ratepayers within the corporate limits of the Town of St. Paul.

The Assessment Review Board shall consist of the seven (7) members of Council, of which the members shall choose a presiding officer. The members of Council shall serve as members of the Assessment Review Board until they are no longer members of Council.

Further, the Municipal Administrator of the Town of St. Paul and/or his designate shall act as the clerk of Assessment Review Board. The duties of the clerk shall be to receive and record all assessment complaints and to ensure proper notices are forwarded as they relate to the time and place of the hearing of the Board.

This By-Law shall come into effect upon the final passing thereof.
