

BY-LAW No. 1065  
OF THE  
TOWN OF ST. PAUL

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF ST. PAUL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD AND TO DEFINE ITS POWERS, DUTIES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of St. Paul deems it advisable and expedient to establish an Economic Development Advisory Board.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of St. Paul duly assembled enacts as follows:

**PART I**

Definitions:

- 1a) "Board" means and includes the Economic Development Advisory Board of the Town of St. Paul.
- b) "Council" means the Council of the Municipality of the Town of St. Paul in the Province of Alberta.
- c) "Town" means the Town of St. Paul.

**PART II**

Appointment/Terms:

- 1) The Board to be known as the St. Paul Economic Development Advisory Board is hereby established.
- 2) The Board shall consist of Eleven (11) member who shall be appointed by resolution of Council. The said Board members shall consist of:
  - a) One (1) member of Council
  - b) One (1) member of the St. Paul Chamber of Commerce preferably an Executive member.

- c) One (1) member of the Agricultural Community.
  - d) One (1) member of the Sports Community.
  - e) One (1) member from the Business Community.
  - f) One (1) member from the Social and Community Service Community.
  - g) Five (5) members from the community at large.
- 3) All members shall be appointed by Council. Recommendations to Council will be made by the Economic Development Advisory Board.

### **PART III**

#### Proceedings:

- 1) Annually, during the month of November, the Board shall amongst its members, elect a Chairperson and a Vice-Chairperson for the ensuing year.
- 2) Meetings of the Board shall be held on a regular basis and at a time to be established by resolution.
- 3) A quorum for meetings of the Board shall be six members.
- 4) Special meetings may be called by the Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson.
- 5) The Board by resolution shall appoint a recording secretary who may or may not be a member of the Board, and whose duties and responsibilities shall be set out by the Board.

### **PART IV**

#### Duties of the Board:

- 1) The Board shall be responsible to guide and direct the economic development initiatives for the Council and community of the Town of St. Paul.
