

BY-LAW NO. 1097
OF THE
TOWN OF ST. PAUL

A By-Law of the Town of St. Paul in the Province of Alberta, to establish the position of Designated Officer.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council may pass a By-Law to establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of St. Paul in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That, the position of Assessor be established to carry out the duties of an Assessor,
as designated in the Municipal Government Act.

This By-Law shall come into affect upon the final passing thereof.

Further, final passing of the By-Law shall repeal By-Law #1049.
