

BY-LAW NO. #1016

OF THE

TOWN OF ST. PAUL

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF ST. PAUL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING AND SELLING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of St. Paul deems it expedient to provide for a By-Law for the purpose of closing to a public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same, and

WHEREAS, notice of the intention of Council to pass a By-Law has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the By-Law.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the Town of St. Paul, in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and disposing of the following described highways, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation.
