

**BY-LAW NO. 1012**

**OF THE**

**TOWN OF ST. PAUL**

**A By-Law of the Municipal Council of the Town of St. Paul  
in the Province of Alberta to Establish Fees Payable by a  
Person or Persons Appealing Their Assessment.**

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta and under the provisions of Section 481 thereof, the Council of the Town of St. Paul in Council enacts as follows;

Whereas, the Council of the Town of St. Paul deems it expedient to implement charges for processing assessment appeals.

Therefore, the Council of the Town of St. Paul enacts as follows.

-Any person or persons filing an appeal or individual as a party or intervenor in a hearing before an assessment review board and for obtaining copies of an assessment review board's decision and other documents will be assessed the following fees.

-A residential property	- \$25.00
-A commercial or industrial property	- \$50.00
-A apartment complex over 4 Units	- \$50.00
