

BY-LAW NO. 828
OF THE
TOWN OF ST. PAUL

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. PAUL IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF ST. PAUL AND THE ST. PAUL CURLING CLUB.

WHEREAS, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act R.S.A., 1980 Chapter M26, Section 127, Sub-section 2 (c and d) and Section 130, Sub-section C; Council may lease Town Owned Facilities to Organizations.

AND WHEREAS, Council has been petitioned by the St. Paul Curling Club to have exclusive use of the Upper Mezzanine of the Curling Rink.

AND WHEREAS, Council deems that, it will be a benefit to the Community to have the Upper Mezzanine turned over to the curling club.

THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of St. Paul in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

The Corporation of the Town of St. Paul hereby agrees to enter into an Agreement with the St. Paul Curling Club, a copy which is attached and forming part of this by-law and marked as Schedule "A".

Upon the final passing of this by-law the Mayor and the Municipal Administrator of the Town of St. Paul are hereby authorized and empowered to execute for and on behalf of the Town of St. Paul, the said agreement.

READ a first time in Council this 12th day of September, 1983.

READ a second time in Council this 19th day of September, 1983.

EAD a third time and passed this 26th day of September, 1983.
