

BY-LAW NO. 1071
OF THE
TOWN OF ST. PAUL

**A By-Law of the Municipal Council of the Town of St. Paul
in the Province of Alberta being a By-Law To Amend
Smoking By-Law #1051 of the Town of St. Paul.**

Whereas, it is deemed expedient to amend Smoking By-Law #1051 of the Town of St. Paul.

Now Therefore, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act and amendments thereto, and by virtue of all other powers it enables, the Council of the Town of St. Paul hereby assembled enacts as follows:

By-Law #1051 is hereby amended as follows:

Recreation Centre & Curling Rink

Delete

The entire facility shall be no smoking, except during times of public assembly, then smoking may be allowed and/or an area may be designated for smoking by the sponsors of the Recreation according to Places of Public Assembly.

Add

The entire facility shall be designated as non-smoking at all times.

The management of the recreation centre and curling rink shall ensure that a sign or signs, as prescribed by Schedule A or otherwise permitted by By-Law #1051 shall be conspicuously posted.

This By-Law shall come into effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a second time in Council this 25th day of March, 2002.

READ a third time in Council and passed this 25th day of March, 2002.
