

BY-LAW NO. 1103
OF THE
TOWN OF ST. PAUL

**A By-Law of the Town of St. Paul, in the Province of Alberta,
for the purpose of closing a portion of a public highway in
accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government
Act, Chapter M26 Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended.**

Whereas, the lands hereafter described as no longer required for public travel,
and

Whereas, application has been made to Council to have the highway lane
closed, and

Whereas, the Council of the Town of St. Paul deems it expedient to provide for a
By-Law for the purpose of closing certain roads to public travel, or portions thereof, situ-
ated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same, and

Whereas, notice of the intention of Council to pass a By-Law has been given in
accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

Whereas, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any per-
son deeming to be prejudicially affected by the By-Law.

Now therefore, be it resolved that the Council of the Town of St. Paul, in the Prov-
ince of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and disposing of the following de-
scribed highways, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation.

Road Closure "A"

All that portion of lane and corner cut-off which lies north of the production east-
erly of the south boundary of Lot 5, Block 1, Plan 922 0972.

Road Closure "B"

All the portion of lane and corner cut-off which lies south of the production east-
erly of the north boundary of Lot 2, Block 5, Plan 982 -0128.

READ a first time this 9th day of February, 2004.

Approved by the Ministries of Transportation this 18th day of May, 2004.

READ a second time this 28th day of June, 2004.

READ a third time and passed this 28th day of June, 2004.
