

BY-LAW NO. 801
OF THE
TOWN OF ST. PAUL

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. PAUL, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO RESCIND BY-LAW NO. 793 AND AMEND BY-LAW NO. 779.

Pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act 1980, and amendments thereto of the Province of Alberta, and under the provisions of Chapter H7, Section 14, 15 and 16 thereof, the Council of the Town of St. Paul enacts as follows:

THAT, By-Law No. 793 is hereby rescinded and further that By-Law No. 779 be and is hereby amended by amending the following clauses under Parking Provisions and Parking (Diagonal Parallel) under Part III of By-Law No. 779 to read as follows:

Parking Provisions

No parking will be allowed on the North and South sides of 50th Avenue from 45th Street to easterly Town limits. Except on the north side of 50th Avenue from 44th Street West, 70 meters where indicated.

Parking (Diagonal, Parallel)

Parking will be angle or diagonal where signs designate where sign designate same, as follows:

- a) Along the west side of 48th Street between 50th and 51st Avenue.
- b) On the south side of the service road off of 50th Avenue between 45th and 44th Street
- c) On the south side of 48th Avenue between 44th and 43rd Street where indicated.

In all cases, diagonal parking is for vehicles not exceeding the size of a ~ ton pick-up truck.

All parking elsewhere within the corporate limits of the town on any public highway, will be parallel.

This By-Law shall come into effect upon the final passing thereof.
